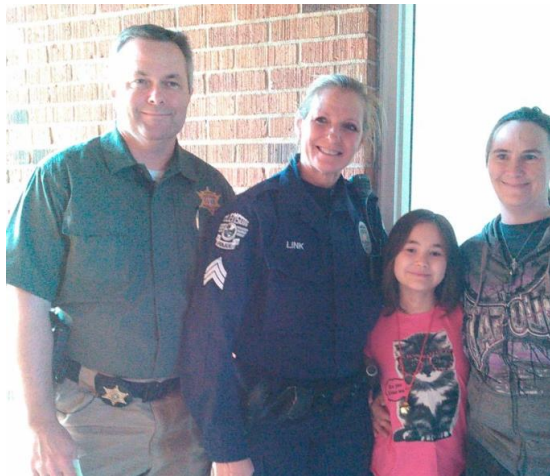

## GOOD VIBES FROM GRIER PARK!

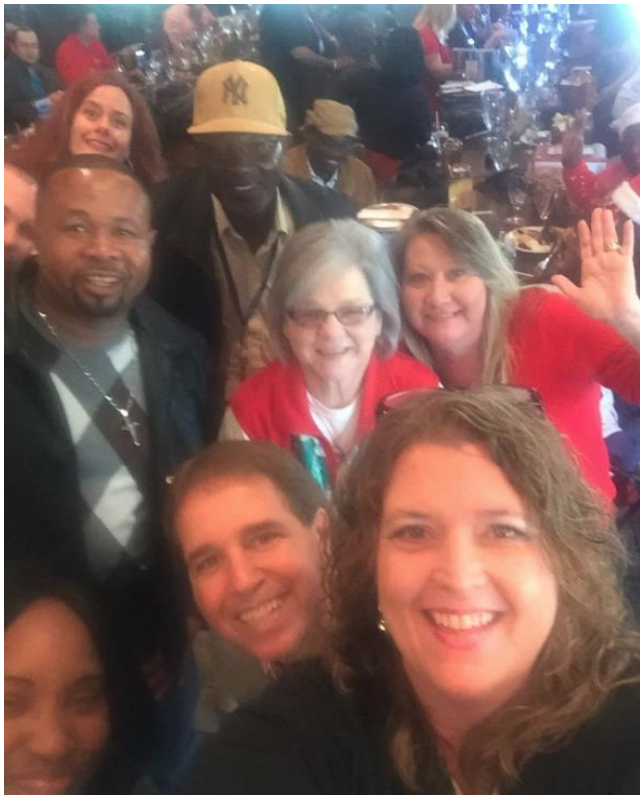

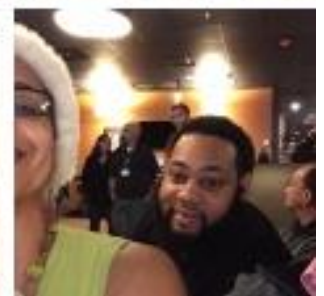
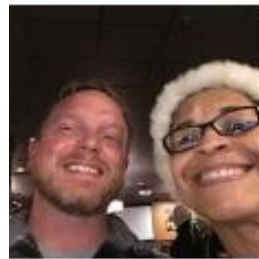
